Thank you! To the community, the staff and the Fundraising Committee for doing what has never been done at Glenhaven.

In two months these groups raised a staggering \$340,000! Never in 60 years has a group done this for Glenhaven, for the community and for the capital campaign for the new addition and renovation.

We had two very special donors from the community as well. On October 23rd they gave us a challenge to raise \$100,000 by Christmas and they would both match that. The committee went well beyond that to raise a total of \$140,000 so with both matches it brought Glenhaven to a total of \$340,000 in two months!

We're not done yet though! Our goal total is \$700,000 to complete the new addition and renovation. The journey began back in 2013 and since then we have raised a grand total of \$445,000.

In the coming year we hope to hear from you. With your help and through word of mouth I know we will raise the remaining \$255,000 to get the job done and assist our community in any way we can.

Chicken Broccoli Bake



2-10 3/4 - oz cans cream of chicken soup
 1 cup mayonnaise
 1 1/4 cups soft bread crumbs, divided
 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese, divided
 1 teaspoon lemon juice
 1/2 teaspoon curry powder
 1/8 teaspoon ground black pepper
 2 16 - oz packages frozen broccoli cuts, thawed and drained
 1- 2 - 2 1/4 - pound roasted chicken, skin and bones removed, meat shredded (3 cups)
 1 tablespoon butter, melted

For sauce: In a medium bowl, combine condensed soup, mayonnaise, 1/4 cup of the bread crumbs, half of the cheese, the lemon juice, curry powder and pepper. Set aside. In a large bowl, combine broccoli, chicken and about two-thirds of the sauce. Turn mixture into a 3-quart rectangular baking dish. Top evenly with remaining sauce.

Combine the remaining cheese and bread crumbs and the melted butter; sprinkle crumb mixture over casserole in dish.

Bake, uncovered, in a 350 degrees oven for 25 to 30 minutes or until heated through.

New Building Grand Opening

It has been a very busy holiday season and now that the New Year is here we are looking soon to occupy the new building. If all goes as planned, the middle of April will be the target date for moving into the new building. As the construction progresses, the households/neighborhoods are really coming together. February 4th is the tentative date for one of several family meetings regarding the relocation of residents from old Glenhaven to the new Glenhaven LTC and Rehab. We are really going to encourage family participation in this move. Every chance staff gets we are discussing the new building and answering questions/concerns residents or family may be having. For many residents this has been their home for a number of years and it will be a big change for them, even though the new building will be state of the art and they will have their own rooms. The private room situation alone has been a milestone as Glenhaven has not had the luxury of providing private rooms to all individuals. We will be assisting residents over to see the new facility, to have choices on rooms and their location and to keep them involved so they feel they had some choice/input in this change.

Our Facility was chosen as one of the 150 Nursing Homes to participate in the Wisconsin Music and Memory Program- Phase II. This program fully funds the equipment and resources needed for 10 residents with dementia to experience personalized music. We finished the program training and now have select residents listening to personalized music through their iPods. The anticipated benefits of the Music and Memory program are the reduction of anti-psychotic and anti-anxiety medications, reduction of sundowning and agitation, reducing the use of bed and chair alarms, and enhancing the engagement and socialization of our residents.
