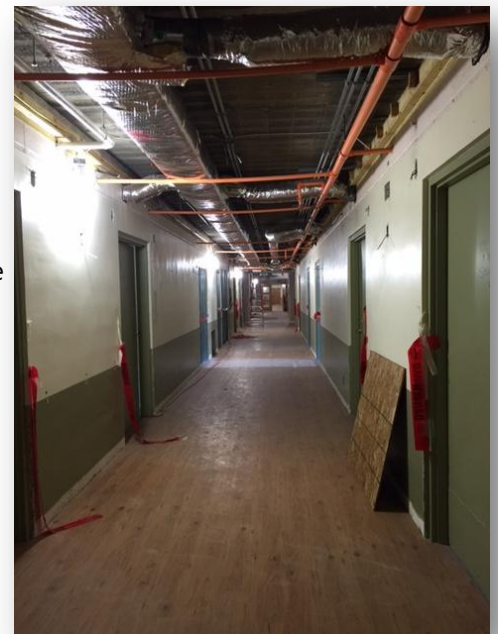

Renovating the "Old" Glenhaven

As some of you may know renovation is not the prettiest thing! It's really a big mess. The "Old" Glenhaven building is currently under a \$1.5 million dollar renovation. The demo is complete and the rough construction is well on its way. Grand Oak's will be licensed through the state of Wisconsin as a Community Based Residential Facility (CBRF). It will be a stepping stone between Havenwood (mostly independent living) and the fully Skilled Nursing Home of Glenhaven LTC and Rehab. It will be best fit for people who need more cares and more assistance but not the increased cost of a nursing home. Royal Construction has stuck with us and is working hard to bring the 16 units (8 efficiency and 8 one bedroom) to a completion by November 1, 2015. This building will include a library and fireplace, large dining room, tavern and theater. We are hoping to have this renovation completed in time for our annual Oktoberfest to be held on October 22, 2015. Please call us at 715-265-4555 for tickets or more information.

Chicken Salad Bake



2 cups cubed, cooked chicken	½ cup real mayonnaise
1 cup chopped celery	1 Tbsp lemon juice
½ cup chopped onion	½ tsp salt
1 (8 oz) can sliced water chestnuts (drained)	½ tsp pepper
½ cup shredded cheddar cheese	1 cup shoestring potatoes

Combine all ingredients, except shoestring potatoes. Put in a 1 ½ quart casserole dish. Sprinkle with shoestring potatoes. Bake at 400° for 20-25 minutes.

May use potato chips or chow mein noodles instead of shoestring potatoes.

We are still under construction. The "Old" Glenhaven building is currently being renovated into 16 units for more assisted living.

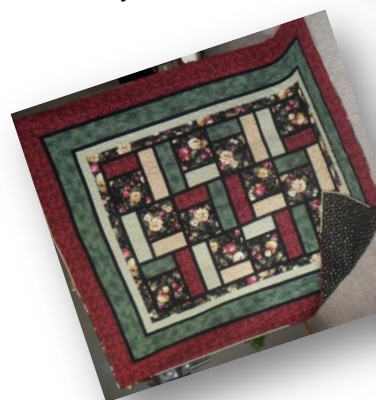
